Naples area, southern Italy or all over the Italy. What is expected to be presented by the national briefers? Should this be military medical event, or it is possible to be part of already existent academic or other civilian Italian forum? Which part of disaster management will be discussed – the first phase (pre-hospital) or the entire process?

What should be the format and the main focus of the event – practical or academic one? Proposal for establishing of medical network – for medical information exchange. Highlighting the significance of the military medical input into disaster relief operation from national and international perspective. Requirement for civilian part to take the lead – as it is in the incident management. Do the Italian disaster managers are interested in the topic?

What outcomes are expected in the proposed courses of action and how the different entities could be involved?

There is interest from Italian Trauma system. Proposal the event to be led by NATO and to start with small drill in Italian Role 2 facility and then to academics, or to start with academic discussions, followed by military capabilities demonstration. Fully support the idea and will involve the representatives from Civil Protection and Ministry of Health in the next meeting.

Proposal to have a three day scientific meeting with 8 presentations a day the first two days and four in the last one, followed by military medical capabilities life presentation. The topics should be management in the damaged area, prehospital organization and planning and training. Guest briefers from Ministry of health, Civil Protection and political authorities are to be invited.

Summary of the decisions

All the participants agreed on the importance and the plausibility of organizing such a scientific forum. The title Civil Military Cooperation and Coordination was accepted. Need of further clarification of the organization and the lead. Requirement for Italian Civil Protection participation.

Requirement of establishing a POC list and regular meeting on three weeks basis.

Target audience of the event -

- 1. incidents commanders
- 2. emergency healthcare providers
- 3. civilian physician /specialists
- 4. military medical specialists

Next meeting will be hosted by Pr. Dr. Giuseppe Noschese in A.O.R.N. "A. Cardarelli" di Napoli within two weeks. Col. Dr. Mattei will be the main coordinator.
