Scientific Rationale for the IDMA (International Disaster Medicine Association) Congress "Vision of Disaster"

Introduction:

The Congress "Vision of Disaster" aims to explore emergency response strategies and victim management in scenarios of natural and man-made disasters. In a context where climate change and geopolitical tensions may increase the frequency and impact of such events, enhancing preparation and cooperation between military and civilian sectors is crucial.

- Mass Casualty Management: The afternoon sessions will discuss the management of mass casualty
 incidents in recent catastrophic events. Analyzing cases such as the Boston Marathon bombing and
 the collapse of the Vela di Scampia will offer critical perspectives on the logistical and operational
 challenges faced.
- <u>Preparation for the Future:</u> The final discussion will focus on how institutions can improve their preparedness for future disaster scenarios, particularly regarding the volcanic risk posed by Vesuvius and the Campi Flegrei. Presentations will address the preparedness of hospitals and emergency services.
- <u>Conclusions:</u> The congress "Vision of Disaster" represents a crucial opportunity to share
 experiences, tackle common challenges, and build a network of professionals engaged in
 emergency management. Collaboration between the civilian and military sectors is essential to
 ensure effective and timely responses in the event of disasters, thus enhancing the resilience of our
 communities.
